Organizations are an important part of our science fair.

High school students from Fairfax County Public Schools and private high schools in Fairfax County participate at the Fairfax County Regional Science and Engineering Fair. To be eligible, the students must have excelled at their school's local fairs. Grand prize winners at the regional fair have the opportunity to compete at the virtual International Science and Engineering Fair in May, 2021.

About 150 organization judges participate, representing over 40 different businesses and professional organizations. These organizations provide a variety of awards to student projects that excel in categories related to the goals of the organizations.
